# **Proposed 2012/13 Season Subscriptions**

The Committee has put forward to following subscriptions rates to be discussed at the AGM.

<u>Full Racing Member</u> - \$350 annual Subscription. If \$100 paid by 30<sup>th</sup> October and an automatic payment set up, then the subscription will be reduced by \$50 to \$300.

Family Subscription - 10% off subsequent family rowers

Associate Members - \$25

<u>Returning University Rowers</u> - \$100 for the summer. If competing in Club regattas over the season a NZ Rowing licence will be required.

Recreational Members – Masters and members not competing in regattas outside of Hawkes Bay - \$200.
